

LYLPS Work Plan 2022 Review

Overview

LYLPS continued to exercise the lake management plan during 2022. Primary activities and results were:

• F	Prevention Continuing support, through C-OFOKLA, of the boat steward program, CCStoptheInvasion.org and including support of the boat decontamination station. Provide content for public outreach, both directly and through C-OFOKLA.	 Performed two updates to the decontamination station software. Provided support to SWCD when boat station was hit by a car. Supporting C-OFOKLA in their outreach efforts including support for the NYSFOLA regional conference at Dwyer Park.
• [Monitoring Monitor the lake through CSLAP Expand the monitoring by developing a macrophyte monitoring program with Soil and Water (SWCD) Develop a HABs monitoring program Support C-OFOKLA flood rapid-response program 	 Successfully completed 8 rounds of water testing for CSLAP. Did not develop either the macrophyte monitoring program or the HAB program. Provided a representative on the flood rapid response team for C-OFOKLA.
• 7	 Treatments Treat variable leaf milfoil in previously untreated areas, focusing on clearing it from "seed" areas. Treat starry stonewort and pondweed through weed harvesting 	 Successful treatment of VLM. Conducted one week of weed harvesting though we wanted to have a second week. No harvesting resources were available. We need to evaluate for future efforts. Starry stonewort was not harvested. Eel weed emerged in late July with surface mats of seed pods.
• [Management Support SWCD shorescaping program Continue support of septic education program Participate in the Tioughnioga River LWRP Update project	 SWCD has not been active with the shorescaping program. We need to re-evaluate how to move forward in support of our community. Providing ongoing support for the septic program.



	We are actively working on the LWRP Update project including developing funding plans for projects at LYL and Dwyer Park.
 Organizational Continue to build community Maintain the lake management plan 	 Successfully held two happy hours, our annual boat parade, annual meeting and fall picnic. Added 3 CSLAP volunteers and a new board member. We need to fold these annual work plans and reviews into the formal lake management plan. Target to complete this by the end of 2022.
